What Is Endangered species?

An endangered species is a species of wild animal or plant that is in danger of extinction throughout all or a significant portion of its range.



What Factors Cause a Species to Become Endangered?

- Destruction, modification, or restriction of habitat resulting from human activity such as agriculture, urban development, mining, deforestation, and pollution.
- Human exploitation of a species for commercial, recreational, scientific, educational, or other purposes that results in critically diminished population numbers.
- Competition and/or displacement by invasive species.
- Disease or predation by other animals to the extent that populations decline significantly.

Who Decides That a Species Is Endangered?

The International Union for the Conservation of Nature is the global authority on endangered species determination. The IUCN compiles information from a network of conservation organizations to rate which species are most endangered, and this information is published in the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species.

IUCN Regional Red Lists assess the risk of extinction to species in over 100 countries and regions around the world.

How Does a Species Become Listed as Endangered?

The IUCN Red List conducts a detailed Assessment Process to evaluate extinction risk based on criteria such as rate of decline, population size, area of geographic distribution, and degree of population and distribution fragmentation.

Information included in the IUCN assessment is obtained and evaluated in coordination with IUCN Species Survival Commission Specialist Groups (authorities responsible for a specific species, group of species, or geographic area). Species are categorized and listed as followed:

Extinct (EX) - No individuals remaining.

How Does a Species Become Listed as Endangered?

Extinct in the Wild (EW) - Known only to survive in captivity, or as a naturalized population outside its historic range.

Critically Endangered (CR) - Extremely high risk of extinction in the wild.

Endangered (EN) - High risk of extinction in the wild.

Vulnerable (VU) - High risk of endangerment in the wild.

Near Threatened (NT) - Likely to become endangered in the near future.

Least Concern (LC) - Lowest risk. Does not qualify for a more at risk category.

Widespread and abundant taxa are included in this category.

Data Deficient (DD) - Not enough data to make an assessment of its risk of extinction.

Not Evaluated (NE) - Has not yet been evaluated against the criteria.
